

Cadence Music Ensemble in Concert at Robert R. McCormick Museum

WHEATON, IL, March 13, 2012 — Cantigny Park's Robert R. McCormick Museum will host the Cadence Music Ensemble on Sunday, April 15, at 3 pm.

Tickets are free, but distribution is by lottery due to limited seating in the museum's historic Freedom Hall. **Those wishing to attend should call 630.260.8162 or email register@cantigny.org** by April 6. E-mails should include a phone number. Cantigny will draw 40 names and contact ticket recipients by April 11. Each winner will receive two tickets.

Cadence Music Ensemble began in 2002 as a duo with founding members Tricia Wlazlo (oboe) and Alan Stocking (percussion). Pianist Sandra Carey joined the ensemble in 2004, which expanded the group's recital repertoire and opened opportunities for new piece commissions.

Performing all genres of classical music, Cadence entertains audiences with their innovative programming and exciting performance style. Rhythm is the key element woven through each work, along with the color and drama provided by percussion.

The Robert R. McCormick Museum at Cantigny Park is open Tuesday through Sunday for complimentary guided tours. Hours are 10 am to 4 pm in March and April.
