

8th Annual Cantigny Car Show on Sept. 15

More than 400 vehicles in all classes expected at popular family-friendly event!

WHEATON, IL, September 4, 2013 — The Cantigny Car Show will take place Sunday, September 15, from 9 am to 3 pm. The event is free to attend and open to the public. Parking for spectators is \$5.

Exhibitors at the 8th annual show will compete for more than 90 awards, including Cantigny Choice and Best of Show. Other prize categories include Best Interior, Best Paint, Best Modified Engine, Lowest Low Rider, Biggest Spoiler and Widest Tire. Awards for youngest and oldest participants will be given, too.

Back for a second year is the Children's Choice Award, which gives kids who attend a chance to vote for their favorite car, truck or motorcycle. With this and other attractions (including a "Cars" theme inflatable slide!), Cantigny strives to be the most family-friendly car show in Chicagoland.

Cantigny Car Show awards are determined by participant voting. One exception is Cantigny Choice, considered the event's grand prize. The 2012 Cantigny Choice winner was a 1937 Ford Custom, exhibited by Duane Pierson of Lockport, IL.

All awards will be presented at 3 pm.

The Cantigny Car Show is a rain or shine event. Food and beverage concessions will be available, along with 50's-style DJ music provided by Carousel Sound.

For exhibitors, the cost of entry is \$12 in advance or \$15 day of show. Parking is complimentary for registered exhibitors, and the first 200 arrivals will receive a free limited-edition Cantigny Car Show t-shirt. Check-in begins at 7 am. Registration forms may be downloaded at Cantigny.org.

The First Division Museum will be exhibiting its historic fleet of military vehicles at the show. The museum, and also the Robert R. McCormick Museum, will be open during the show. Admission to both museums is free. Visitors may also enjoy a stroll through Cantigny's beautiful gardens.

Cantigny Park is open every day through October from 7 am to dusk. A complete schedule of events is posted online at Cantigny.org. Annual memberships starting at \$50 include unlimited free parking and other benefits.
