

“Rabbit Ears” Ensemble at McCormick Museum on Feb. 17

Complimentary performance will open museum’s 2013 concert series

WHEATON, IL, Jan. 8, 2013 — Cantigny Park’s Robert R. McCormick Museum will host the flute and guitar ensemble [Rabbit Ears](#) on Sunday, Feb. 17, at 3 pm.

Flutist Carlyn Lloyd and guitarist Pamela Kimmel perform light classical music such as Bach, Beethoven and Handel as well as favorites by Cole Porter, George Gershwin and Irving Berlin.

Concert tickets are free, but distribution is by lottery due to limited seating in the museum’s historic Freedom Hall. **Those wishing to attend should call 630.260.8162 or email register@cantigny.org by February 8.** E-mails should include a phone number. Cantigny will draw 40 names and contact ticket recipients by February 13. Each winner will receive two tickets.

The 2013 McCormick Museum Concert Series will continue with the Naperville Chamber Players on Sunday, March 10, followed by the Chicago New Arts Trio on Sunday, April 21. Details are online at [Cantigny.org](#). All concerts in the series are free; parking is \$5 per vehicle.

The McCormick Museum is closed in January and will reopen Feb. 1 for free guided tours. Hours in February are 10 am to 4 pm, Friday through Sunday. The museum returns to its usual Tuesday through Sunday tour schedule in March.
