## **Rick “Elvis” Saucedo to Play Outdoor Concert on July 7**

**WHEATON, IL, June 18, 2012** — He sounds like Elvis. He looks like Elvis. And now he’s planning to rock Cantigny Park like Elvis on Saturday, July 7.

Rick Saucedo and The Change of Habit Band will perform in front of the First Division Museum at 8 pm. For those who enjoy the music and excitement of Elvis Presley, this special summer concert under the stars is not to be missed!

Chicago-born Saucedo, the self-styled “Prince of Rock ‘n Roll,” is widely regarded as one of the earliest and consistently best tribute performers in America. This year marks his 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary as an Elvis tribute artist, an act that began after Saucedo heard the song “Burning Love” in 1972.

An accomplished singer, musician and songwriter, Saucedo performed the lead role in the 1978 Broadway musical, *Elvis: The Legend Lives*. He enjoys a massive following in the Chicago area, which was apparent when Saucedo played a bandshell concert at Cantigny in 2011. The upcoming concert will be longer, with two sets and one intermission.

Tickets for the July 7 special concert are \$10 in advance or \$15 the day of show. Parking is complimentary for ticket holders. The park will close at 6 pm for the concert.
