



Cantigny Golf Introduces “Welcome to Golf” Clinics for Adults and Families

Five sessions are available for each clinic with the first sessions starting in May. The exception is the Family Clinic, which will be conducted three times with the first session in June. Weekday evening and weekend clinics are available.
