

## **Maevis Jazz at McCormick Museum April 13**

*Complimentary performance will conclude museum's 2014 concert series*

**WHEATON, IL, March 10, 2014** — Cantigny Park's Robert R. McCormick Museum will host [Maevis Jazz](#) on Sunday, April 13, at 3 pm.

Maevis Jazz features Ken Paoli, keyboards; David Kublank, saxophone; Michael Fiorino, bass; and Chuck Schwartz on drums. The group performs jazz standards from the Swing Era to Be-bop and Cool, and includes many original contemporary jazz compositions.

Concert tickets are free (with \$5 parking), but distribution is by lottery due to limited seating in the museum's historic Freedom Hall. **Those wishing to attend should call 630.260.8162 or email [register@cantigny.org](mailto:register@cantigny.org) by April 4.** E-mails should include a phone number. Cantigny will draw 40 names and contact ticket recipients by April 9. Each winner will receive two tickets.

The McCormick Museum is open for free guided tours, Tuesday through Sunday. Hours are 10 am to 4 pm on weekdays, and noon to 4 pm on Saturdays and Sundays. Extended hours apply starting in May. The museum is closed on Mondays.

The McCormick Museum is a historic house museum interpreting the life and legacy of Colonel Robert R. McCormick (1880-1955), longtime editor and publisher of the *Chicago Tribune*. It is located at Cantigny, the Colonel's 500-acre Wheaton (Illinois) estate that he left as a gift to the public. Cantigny Park, part of the nonprofit Chicago-based Robert R. McCormick Foundations, is home to 30 acres of spectacular gardens, the Robert R. McCormick Museum, the First Division Museum and a 27-hole championship golf course. All are open to the public. Cantigny also is a popular destination for special events, weddings, concerts, lectures, workshops and other recreation and learning opportunities for all ages.
