
Tickets on Sale for “Jenny & the Old House”

WHEATON, IL, October 8, 2013 — Tickets are now on sale for “Jenny & the Old House,” an outdoor roving theater performance amid Cantigny Park’s beautiful fall gardens. Two performances, at 11 am and 1 pm, will take place on Saturday, Oct. 26, and Sunday, Oct. 27. The event is highly recommended for families with children ages 10 and under.

“Jenny & the Old House,” by Mark Adamczyk, is presented by the cast and crew of Lake Forest-based [Citadel Theatre Company](#). It’s a light-hearted tale delivered by professional actors who move about the Cantigny grounds, performing in different settings. The story itself is about a kid, Jenny, who is old enough to do things on her own and make new friends. But one of her errands takes her and her companions past “the creepy old Weaver house” as darkness settles in. Holding their fears in check, they begin a search for the truth about the old place.

Tickets are \$10 per person for ages 5 and up. They are available in advance at Cantigny Park, online at [Cantigny.org](#) or by phone at 630.260.8162. A limited number of tickets are expected to be available on the day of performance. Parking is free for ticketholders.

Spectators may wish to bring blankets or lightweight portable chairs. Seating during the performance is on the lawn.
