Cantigny Guidelines

For your safety and enjoyment, please observe the following guidelines. We appreciate your cooperation.

- You may ride bicycles into the park for transportation, but please park them in bike racks upon arrival.
- In-line skates, scooters and skateboards are not permitted in the park.
- Sports activities are only allowed on the Parade Field adjacent to the parking area.
- Service dogs are welcome. Pets are prohibited.
- Alcoholic beverages and firearms are prohibited on the grounds.
- Please leave the flowers, fruits and vegetables in their natural habitat for others to enjoy.
- A photography permit may be required. Please visit Cantigny.org for more information.

Outdoor Recreation

Enjoy outdoor activities amid the beautiful, natural setting at Cantigny:

- Hike along two and a half miles* of trails through native trees, shrubs and grasses, observing birds and other wildlife. **Some trails closed due to Project New Leaf.*
- Binoculars may be borrowed from the Visitors Center kiosk.
- Dine al fresco at our shaded picnic area—no reservations required.
